The project is about 60% complete, with windows and stone veneer going up. The contract will call for a 50% Fire Marshall inspection, and at that time, the building will be climatized, and the interior finishes will be started. June 2025 is the estimated completion date.

Beaston asked what the \$8,400 on the Courthouse was for on #17. Cartwright stated he had seen the invoice, but I cannot tell you off the top of my head.
